The Lake Tahoe Community College (LTCC) Mobility Hub project includes two 500 kW overhead, fast chargers the first of their kind nationwide—to accommodate a 10-minute guickcharge for two Proterra buses along with two 60 kW pedestal, overnight chargers at two newly constructed shelters with passenger amenities including heated ADA-accessible sidewalks, bicycle storage and maintenance station, and passenger notification screens.
